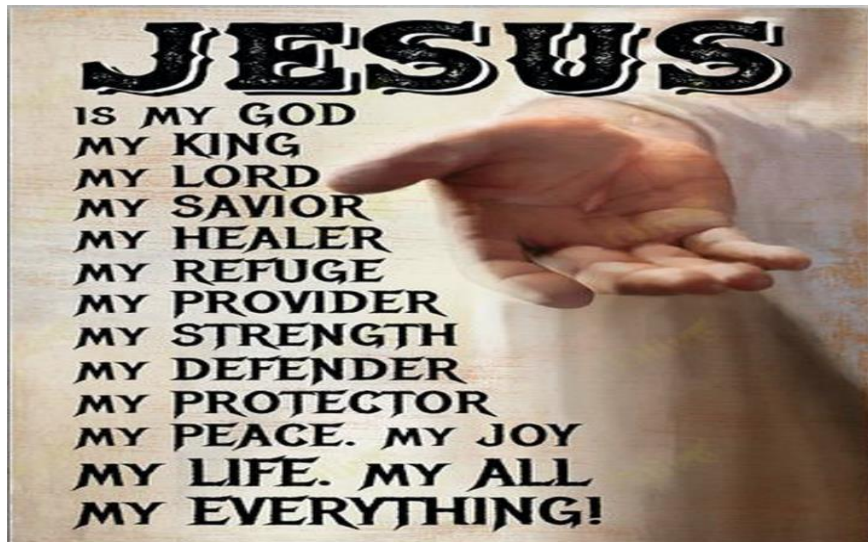

A word on the WORD (Matt. 16:13-20; Cp. Mark 8:27-33; Luke 9:18-22.)

Having read the parallel story in Mark & Luke you will have noted Matt :16 :17-19 is excluded. I too will exclude them in this comment.

The seminal question facing the Church is the one posed in today's lesson WHO IS JESUS OF NAZARETH? Hundreds of books have been written on this question; indeed, the Gospels are the response to that question. Mark in particular places the question at the very centre of the Gospel .It is significant that thereafter the nature of the teaching of Jesus has an emphasis on his coming suffering.

For the early Church Jesus is the divine Messiah come to save (rescue) his people and set them free to be the people Yahweh had intended them to be – a blessing. The initial silence on the part of Jesus as to who he was is an intentional waiting until the disciples came to 'see' who he was and the implications for them? Does his divinity consist of the inherent God love that leads to the Cross? (Harry Lucas)
