A word on the WORD – Matthew 18:15-20

When on Sabbatical leave in 1983 in the U.S.A. I asked how many denominations were there in the country. More than 1200 and growing was the answer. Mainly these divisions grew out of unresolved differences within different denominations.

So how might we handle our complaints and differences?

The UCA does have a process which has in mind restoration and reconciliation as an outcome and invites the complainant to follow a particular procedure. Ignoring the problem and hoping I will go away is not one of them.
