

A word on the WORD (Matthew 22:34-46) Compare Mark 12:35-37a; Luke 10:25-28.

The Sadducees and Pharisees were enemies. They differed on their interpretation of the LAW (Torah) The Sadducees believed that the scriptural record was the only basis for interpretation, while the Pharisees clung firmly to the assertion that other practices and traditions not written into scripture must also be part of the tradition. Historically the Sadducees went back to the time of David, (1000 B.C.) whereas the Pharisees movement appears around 100 B.C. They were the more popular of the two, but both were in alliance against Jesus whom they regarded as a mutual threat. Jesus was on about the relationship of love in the Covenant. God-love was a gift rather than something to be earned. Should you have time to look at the comparative passages you will notice that Matthew and Luke add a sting in the tail at the end of what Jesus says. **(Harry Lucas 0407 483 926)**
