

A word on the WORD Matthew 25:1-13

The parable is in answer to the question of the disciples in 24:3. Ten young women feature: a focus in the parables that up to this point in time was on men's blindness. The parable focuses on the question of being prepared for a future without the physical Jesus. There are different interpretations: 1. This parable refers to the Second Coming, 2. That this refers to the coming of the Holy Spirit at Penecost.3. That his resurrection appearances after death will continue, be sudden and unexpected. Be prepared! How? As a people of the Spirit, practising the insight that looks always for what is going on in what is happening. Daily practising the presence of the Divine.
