## Bible Reading: Exodus 20:8-11

One of the most important laws in the Ten Commandments is the law to honour the Sabbath. In Exodus, it takes four verses to describe the law: four times more than most of the other laws! And the reason for the Sabbath is clearly expressed: "For in six days the LORD made heaven and earth ... but rested the seventh day; therefore, the LORD blessed the sabbath day and consecrated it." (Exodus 20:11 NRSV)

Thus, the Sabbath is not only a requirement of the Torah; it is ingrained in the foundation of creation itself. Rest is not only a human invention; it is the way the world has been created. Even more: it is how God operates! God creates us with an intrinsic need to stop and to rest and to recharge. To work continuously without stopping is against our nature.

Sadly, some people cannot stop until they are burnt out. Some who experience burning out, however, say that the experience actually saves them: their job, their marriage, their relationships, etc. So, perhaps, burning out is a way God warns us that we are created to rest; that we cannot reach our potential until we honour the way God creates us. **Rev.
