Bible Reading: Luke 6:17-26

Feelings are neutral. There is no 'good' or 'bad' feeling. It is how we respond to what we feel that is either good or bad. That is why, for Jesus, experiencing uncomfortable feeling is not only OK; it can actually be a blessing. Comfort can distort our perspective. Wealth can obscure our view of the heavenly realm on earth. Thing—like fame or power—that we consider as an advantage can hinder us from experiencing the fullness of God's presence. Indeed, God's realm that Jesus proclaims has different values from the values of the world. In that realm, the poor, the downtrodden, the mourner, and the marginalized are highly regarded; vulnerability is a virtue and not a problem to be solved; the weak discovers true power and the powerful is taught to learn from the weak. Jesus has ushered this new realm into the world—and we get a glimpse of this realm in our vulnerability.

So, let us embrace our vulnerability. As we do that, may we find God who is the source of all healings and life.
