Bible Reading: Proverbs 31:10-31

There is one thing that women often face: comparison. Yes, women are often being compared to other women. If you are a woman, you may feel bad about yourself when you read about the 'ideal' wife/mother in Proverbs 31. You may feel that you have not done as much as the 'ideal' wife/mother in the proverb! But this takes us to the key and pivotal verse in the proverb: verse 29 that says, "Many women have done excellently, but you surpass them all." (New Revised Standard Version of the Bible) Here the proverb moves from using the third person pronoun, 'she', to the second person pronoun, 'you'. The proverb is no longer talking *about* the 'ideal' wife /mother'; the proverb is now talking *to* the special woman.

Indeed, the best and most biblical gift that you can give to the woman in your life—whether she is your wife or your mother or your daughter—is the gift of loving her for who she is; the gift of not comparing her to others, not even to the 'ideal' wife/mother in Proverbs 31. The greatest gift you can give to your wife/mother/daughter today is to look her in the eyes and say, "Other women may have done so many things; but YOU—yes YOU—exceed them all!"
