Bible Reading: 1 Corinthians 13 & 1 John 4:7-16

There are many words for love in the Greek language. There is *phileo*, which is a general kind of love like the love between friends. There is *eros*, which is a sexual kind of love like the passionate love between two lovers. There is *stergo*, which is the kind of love between a subordinate and his superior. And there is *agape*, by far the most common word for love in the New Testament writings, including our two readings today.

Agape is the kind of unconditional love that God shows to us. God loves us regardless of who we are or what we have done. God loves us no matter what. Agape is love regardless of and not love because of. Indeed, everything changes: the weather changes; economic or political situation changes, people change. But love—if it is true and genuine—remains because true and genuine love is unconditional **Rev. Toby Keva**




