**Bible Reading: 1 Corinthians 13 & 1 John 4:7-16**

There are many words for love in the Greek language. There is *phileo*, which is a general kind of love like the love between friends. There is *eros*, which is a sexual kind of love like the passionate love between two lovers. There is *stergo*, which is the kind of love between a subordinate and his superior. And there is *agape*, by far the most common word for love in the New Testament writings, including our two readings today.

*Agape* is the kind of unconditional love that God shows to us. God loves us regardless of who we are or what we have done. God loves us no matter what. *Agape* is love *regardless of* and not love *because of*. Indeed, everything changes: the weather changes; economic or political situation changes, people change. But love—if it is true and genuine—remains because true and genuine love is unconditional

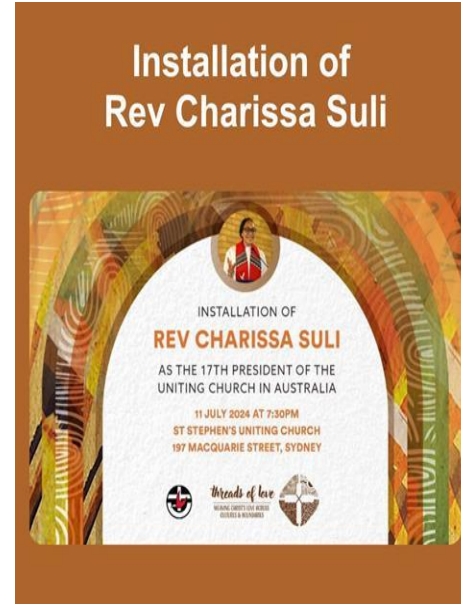

On Thursday 11 July, the 17th Assembly meeting in Sydney, NSW, will open with worship and the installation of Rev Charissa Suli as the 17th President of the Uniting Church in Australia. The President is the spiritual leader and the representative of the Uniting Church nationally. Opening worship will be held at 7.30pm AEST on Thursday 11 July at St Stephen's Uniting Church, 197 Macquarie Street, Sydney. The service will also be livestreamed at 5.30pm AWST with details coming soon.
