

According to the Torah, a life taken must be replaced by another life. "But if anyone schemes and kills someone deliberately, that person is to be taken from my altar and put to death (Exodus 21:14 NIV)." David had obviously broken this law and deserved death, but God somehow spared his life. Now, you may rightly think that it was grossly unfair that other people would have to pay for David's crime. At the same time, no matter how hard it is for us to understand, the narrative actually would like to paint a picture of God as a divine being who is not only concerned about justice, but also about mercy. Indeed, the Hebrew Scriptures present to us a God who is not only just, but merciful. The New Testament goes even further by declaring that "Kind mercy wins over harsh judgment every time (James 2:13 The Message)." That is one of the most fundamental tenets of Christian faith. We believe not only in justice, but also in mercy, in forgiveness. We believe that even the most hardened criminal deserves kindness and mercy.
