

#### Bible Reading: Ephesians 4:20–5:2

If we reduce the reading from the Ephesians to a list of dos and don'ts, we will end up with a list of very demanding expectations. But is it at all possible for anyone to meet these expectations? The answer is, "Yes!" We are indeed required to live up to the expectations in this passage. But "How?" The key is Ephesians 5:1 (NRSV): "Therefore be imitators of God...." We are called to imitate God; to transcend ourselves; to look beyond ourselves to the Divine. At the same time, we are to look to others just like Christ "loved us and gave himself up for us...." (Ephesians 5:2 NRSV) Indeed, when we look and go beyond ourselves to God and to others, then those expectations in the Ephesians will become our nature; our characters. No, it does not mean that we will never fall short of those expectations. But these expectations will become our 'north star' that will guide our life; the ideals that are worthy of our best effort to attain. **(Rev. Toby Keva)**
