In our reading from John's Gospel, Jesus reminds us that he is "the living bread that came down from heaven (John 6:51 NRSV)." Jesus then invited all to 'feast' on him. In other words. Jesus did not come into the world to take something from us, but to give himself away for us. Indeed, in Jesus, we can see what is in God's heart: we can see that our God is a God whose passion is to give Godself away and not to take from those whom God loves. 'Feasting' on Jesus is also the way for us to find eternal life. So, to have 'eternal life' or 'life in its fullness/abundance.' which is another expression for eternal life. in John's Gospel (see John 10:10 NRSV)—we have to become one with Jesus. In other words, we have to be like him and live the kind of life that he lived: a life that does not take from others, but a life that is given for others; a life that is devoted to others. (Rev.
