Bible Reading: James 2:1-13

Contrary to what today's world tells us, as Christians, we believe that there still a 'law' that governs our life. No, this law does not guarantee that we will be successful in life if we follow it. It is actually more possible that we will find difficulty by abiding by this law. But, true Christian surrenders herself to what the letter of James calls as the 'law of liberty' (James 1:25). True freedom is found not by being above or living without any law—by doing whatever we desire; true freedom is found in surrendering ourselves to what the letter of James calls the 'royal law'. But, what is this royal law? According to the letter of James, the royal law is this: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself ..." (James 2:8 NRSV) In the example in the letter, someone who loves others like herself will not entertain a wealthy sister while treating her poor sister badly; a person who abides by this royal law will treat all people equally, just like she wants to be treated. 


