Bible Reading: Mark 9:42-48

Now, you will be relieved to know that NONE of Jesus' parables is meant to be read literally! So, Jesus never says that people who become stumbling blocks should literally be drowned alive. He never says that people should also literally mutilate themselves to enter the Kingdom of God. By using hyperboles, Jesus simply reminds us that those stumbling blocks, which can stop people from coming to him, can actually be the things that we hold dearly in life; things like our own hands and eyes. They can be the way we always do things or traditions that we hold dearly. The challenge to all of us is to value those things as only secondary to the more important thing: helping other people know Christ and find fulfillment in him.
