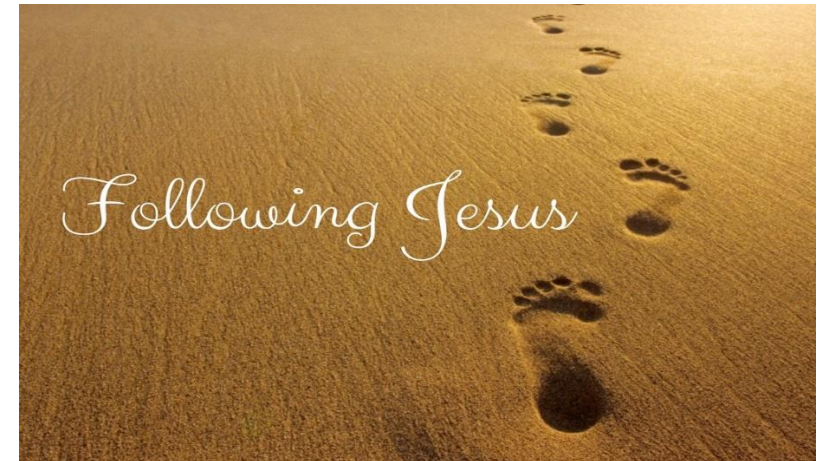

**Bible Reading: Mark 9:30-37**

Who is the Greatest sports person Of All Time (GOAT)? We will get different answer from different people. Jesus' disciples entered into the same kind of debate more than 2000 years ago. They too argued about who was the GOAT among them! But Jesus' answer to the question must have disappointed all of them. "The greatest of all," he said, "is not the first, but the last of all." He turned the notion of greatness upside down. Jesus further emphasized this by talking about a little child. The child was a metaphor for those who were often ignored; those who had no status or power or wealth in his society. To be great in God's Kingdom, one must be ready to associate oneself with these kinds of people. And that was what Jesus' mission was all about. He identified himself with the marginalized. As a consequence, he too suffered the shame that these people endured. May we follow in Jesus' footsteps, identifying ourselves with the marginalized, building relationship with the neglected, and, perhaps, like Jesus, ready to suffer with them and for them.

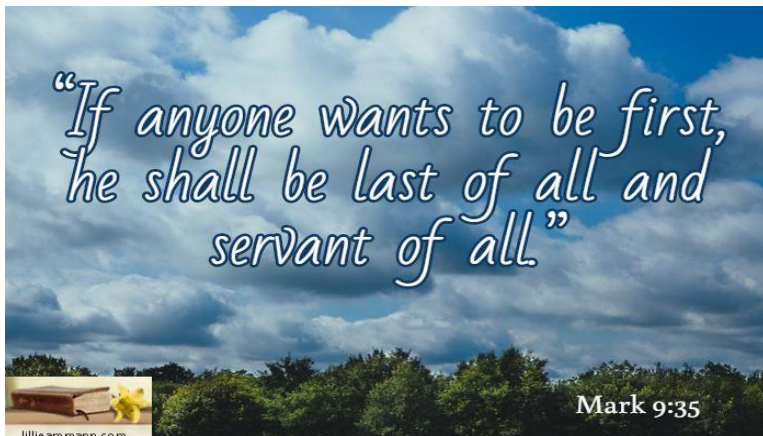
