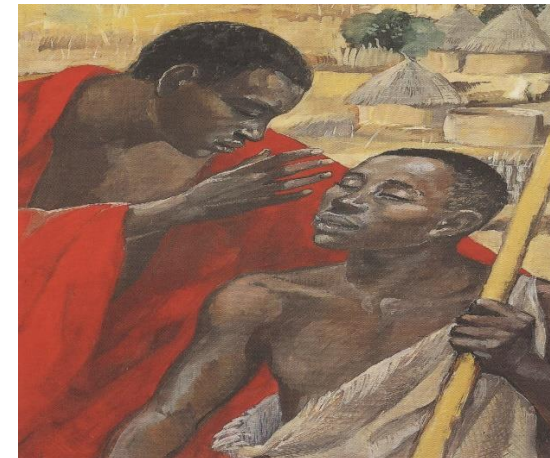

Bible Reading Mark 10:46-52

Blindness is a two-edged sword. It affects not only the person who is blind, but also others around him. Just like the blind person loses the ability to see properly, people around him also loses sight of the blind person. In other words, the blind person becomes invisible, irrelevant. We can see this in our text from Mark's Gospel. When Bartimaeus shouted to get Jesus' attention, others shouted him down! They told him to be quiet! But why? I guess those around him wanted him to go back to his place; to stay invisible and irrelevant. But Jesus saw and acknowledged him and, in that very moment, Bartimaeus was no longer invisible. This step of him being seen and known was the first and crucial step in his healing. Bartimaeus was *healed* even before Jesus *cured* his physical blindness. Indeed, to be seen and known and named and, eventually, included are significant steps of healing and wholeness for all, especially those with disability then and today.
