#### Reflection On Bible Isaiah 58:13-14

The commandment to keep the Sabbath was given to the people living in an agrarian society; the people who did back—breaking manual labour day after day, tilling the land to grow food; the slaves who had no choice but to do whatever their masters told them to; the foreign workers who had little to no rights; even the animals who were often forgotten. So, at the heart of the commandment to keep the Sabbath is the commandment to put limits on ourselves and on others. The law of Sabbath is the law of enough as against the law of excess. Our consumeristic world today likes to tell us that we need to have more and more to be happy and fulfilled. But there will never be enough and we will require ourselves and others to run faster and faster. The law of the Sabbath shows us a different path. It tells us that we will find fulfillment in life when we become whom God has created us to be; when we put constraints on our wants; when we learn to have 'enough' instead of 'more'.(Rev. 
