



Reflection On Reading : Genesis 32:22-31

On the surface level, the story of Jacob on the banks of the river Jabbok sounds like just another episode in the long story about the family of Isaac and his twin sons, Jacob and Esau; or another episode in the larger story of the birth of the tribes of Israel. But our story is more than a 'genealogical' story of Israel's 'fore-family'. The story is a 'typological' story about an encounter with the Divine. In other words, the story serves as a 'blue-print' for our own encounter with the Divine. Friends, a true encounter with God does not leave us 'unscathed.' A true encounter with God will change us for good. In other words, prayer—which, after all, is about an encounter with God—is about God changing us and not about us changing God! Prayer is not about shaping God to fit our wish; prayer is about allowing ourselves to be shaped to fit the wish of the Divine in our life. In other words, prayer is not about asking God for what we want; prayer is about asking God for what God wants for our life. Prayer is about surrendering our will to the will of the Divine. (Rev. 
