**Reflection On Reading: Exodus 19:16-25, 24:12-18 & Matthew 17:1-9.**

We are told that, in Mount Sinai, Moses spends time with God for '40 days and 40 nights'—which means that Moses spends a 'very long time' with God up in the mountain. The Jews believed that it is then when Moses receives the instructions which would later become the books of the Torah. For the Hebrews, God reveals Godself in the books of the Torah. So, by learning and obeying the books of the Torah, the people can encounter the Divine without being consumed by God's holiness! Now, we can see many similarities between this episode in Exodus with the episode in the Gospel of Matthew of Jesus being transfigured before his disciples. And this is the key message of this particular episode in the Gospel of Matthew: just like the people of Israel could encounter the living God via the Torah, we can also encounter the fullness of God in the person of Jesus of Nazareth. Christianity, therefore, is a faith in which God's main revelation is not a book—not even the Bible—but a person: Jesus of Nazareth, the Christ. It is in him that we can encounter the fullness of the presence and the being of God without fear of being consumed by God's otherness. **(Rev. Toby Keva)**

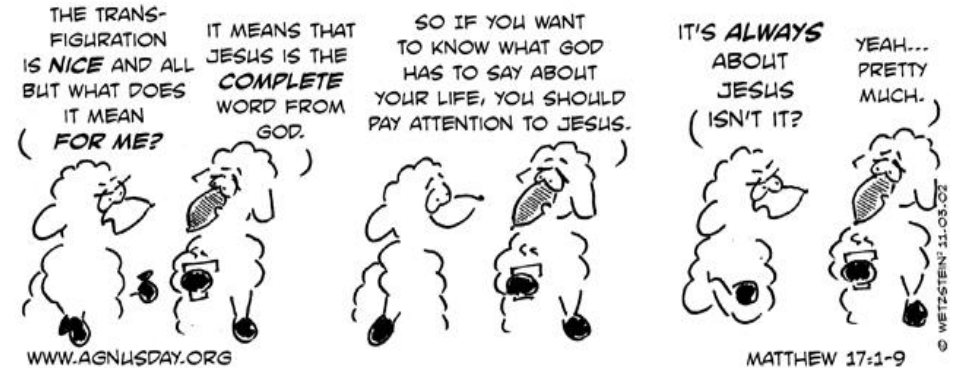
**Keynote Speaker: Ken Sumner**

Six days later, Jesus took with him Peter and James and his brother John and led them up a high mountain, by themselves. And he was transfigured before them, and his face shone like the sun, and his clothes became dazzling white. Suddenly there appeared to them Moses and Elijah, talking with him. Then Peter said to Jesus, "Lord, it is good for us to be here; if you wish, I will make three dwellings here, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." While he was still speaking, suddenly a bright cloud overshadowed them, and from the cloud a voice said, "This is my Son, the Beloved; with him I am well pleased; listen to him!" When the disciples heard this, they fell to the ground and were overcome by fear. But Jesus came and touched them, saying, "Get up and do not be afraid." And when they looked up, they saw no one except Jesus himself alone. As they were coming down the mountain, Jesus ordered them, "Tell no one about the vision until after the Son of Man has been raised from the dead."
